



Risk Disclosure

Scuba Diving is an Adventure Activity and as such has associated Risks & Hazards. Before you participate in Scuba Diving activities with Global Dive you will need to understand, and agree to the following:

Equipment

You must use all required equipment at all times as appropriate for the activity. Equipment provided by Global Dive is regularly inspected and maintained, however there is always a potential risk of equipment malfunction. If using your own equipment it must be a complete set, in working condition, and fit correctly.

Physical Injury or Illness

Accidents happen and despite all the safeguards Global Dive and the Dive Industry have in place there is always a potential risk of physical injury. These may include but are not limited to:

Slips / Trips/ Falls/ Strains, Impact injury, Drowning, Decompression illness, Ear or lung barotrauma, Air embolism, Hyperthermia, Hypothermia, Gas toxicity, Ear infection, Dehydration, UV/Sun exposure, Marine life injuries, Motion sickness, Death

Physical and Mental Medical Conditions

There are some preexisting medical conditions and/or medications that are not compatible with scuba diving. Please make sure you have read and signed the recreational dive medical statement ([link](#)), and if you have any concerns (answer yes to any of the questions) regarding your fitness to dive, you have written medical clearance from your doctor prior to participating.

Natural Hazards

Scuba Diving is an in-water activity and when conducted at an Open Water site, is exposed to nature and the elements. The risks & hazards you may encounter include but are not limited to:

UV/Sun exposure, Hyperthermia, Hypothermia, Marine life blooms, Adverse weather, Heavy seas, Entanglements, slips/rockfalls, Natural disaster e.g. Tsunami, Earthquake, Coastal Erosion

- I agree to dive within my training, certification, experience, ability and comfort
- I will dive with and be proficient with my dive computer and follow my dive plan
- I will answer the medical statement honestly and inform Global Dive of any concerns that I may have regarding my fitness to dive.
- In the event of an injury, accident or illness, I consent to receiving medical treatment from Global Dive or their representatives
- I will follow all instructions and briefings given by Global Dive or their representatives and I will communicate any concerns or issues I have.
- I understand that Global Dive may need to cancel or postpone an activity if there is a concern for my safety or the safety of another participant.
- I understand the associated risks and hazards of Scuba Diving, including serious harm and death. I accept this risk and agree to proceed with the activity.
